

Guess Who

Steps for the Strategy

1. Write a name on an index card (cartoon character, movie star, body part).
2. Tape cards to forehead or back so everyone but the student may see who or what they are.
3. Students should ask yes or no questions to deduce the name on their forehead or back.
4. Students should ask one question per person.
5. Once they figure it out, they can put the card on the front of their shirt and walk around giving hints to the other students about who or what their card says.

Management Tips

1. Circulate during the activity to help students stay on task.
2. Taping the cards on as the students enter the room may save time.
3. Remind students not to tell each other the names on the cards.

Variations

1. Give students a list of yes or no questions to ask.
2. Use vocabulary from a unit you are covering to help students review.
